2. Ensure that your application form is completed including residential address, signature and date.
3. Include this completed checklist when you lodge your visa application form and supporting documentation.

**Other important information**

Please be aware that the decision on your visa application may be decided based on the information and documentation included with your application at time of lodgement.

Please ensure that you:

- Do not submit original documents with your application, such as your passport, unless requested;
- Write legibly.

If birth certificate is late registered, a copy of hospital records where the applicant was born duly certified by the hospital is required.</li> <li>2. Evidence of Enrolment at school, college or university.</li> </ol> <p><b>NB: A Travel Permit from the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) does not constitute consent.
